1. Imputed

Under Adam – I. Cor. 15:22

2. Inherited

Sin nature – Ps. 51:5

Judgments of God

- I. Unsaved → eternal condemnation

- II. Saved
 - a) Salvation → Jesus took our judgment
 - b) Discipline → for purification
 - c) At death → for rewards

All Men

- I. Are slaves
 - A) To self → sin → flesh → world → Satan
 - B) To Jesus Christ

Paradox: Must become a slave (to Jesus)
To be free of slavery (to self)

- III. Eternally glorify Jesus
 - A) display His justice → Lake of Fire
 - B) display His grace → Heaven

Fallacies of Man
